#### C. Approval of 24-25 Schools of Choice for Grades 1-10

WHEREAS, the Clawson Board of Education has the option permitted by Section 105 of the State School Aide Act of 1979, as amended by Public Act 300 of 1998; and

WHEREAS, it has the option, for the purpose of Section 105, to accept applications of nonresident students from outside the District who reside in the Oakland Intermediate School District, of which this district is a constituent district, for the enrollment in our district for the 2024-2025 school year; and

WHEREAS, the Clawson Board of Education has the option to operate a Schools of Choice Program for the first semester in compliance with the statutory requirements of Section 105; and

WHEREAS, the Clawson Board of Education has outstanding school programs and there may be room for students from other districts to participate in these high-quality schools.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Clawson Public Schools chooses to participate in the aforementioned Schools of Choice Program for the first semester of 2024-2025; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Clawson Public Schools will accept applications on an unlimited basis for the first semester of the 2024-2025 school year for Grades 1 through 10 beginning April 17, 2024 through August 23, 2024.

# **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

#### A. <u>Property Sale – Baker</u>

Bill Bowmen from Great Lakes Consulting Group executed a comprehensive plan to ensure significant interest from developers in the proposal process. The district committee reviewed each of the proposals and interviewed all developers. After completion of the interviews, a timeframe was opened to allow each developer an opportunity to refine their proposals based on the feedback from the committee. The committee met with the Board Finance Committee to discuss their findings and to develop a recommendation for the sale of Schalm. With the concurrence of the Board Finance Committee, a recommendation for the sale of Schalm to Robertson Bros/SDC was approved by the Board of Education on March 18, 2024. Upon completion of some due diligence, the committee met with the Finance Committee on April 15, 2024, and a recommendation to the Board for the sale of Baker is anticipated after that meeting.

Approval for the sale of Baker will be presented to the Board at the May 20, 2024 Board meeting.

#### B. <u>Contract with Pediatric Health Consultants</u>

Clawson Public Schools has contracted with Pediatric Health Consultants for over 10 years to meet the special education service requirements, including the ASD Center Program and the non-public schools within Clawson. Clawson Schools has been satisfied with the services and staff of Pediatric Health Consultants. Pediatric Health Consultants has provided Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Recreational Therapy services. Services are budgeted between the general fund, IDEA Federal Funds, and the ASD Center Program Budget. It is anticipated costs will be \$157,000-

\$168,000 for therapy services with Pediatric Health Consultants for the 2024-25 school year.

Approval of the contract will be presented to the Board at the May 20, 2024 Board meeting.

#### C. <u>Contract with Cross Country Education</u>

The Clawson ASD Center Program has been in need of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst, BCBA, to support the ASD program. This past school year Clawson Public Schools worked with Cross Country Education to contract with a part time BCBA. The limited time within the program demonstrated the benefit of having the expertise of a BCBA on the ASD Team. Service costs are 100% ASD Center Program budget. It is anticipated costs will be \$84,000 for BCBA services with Cross Country Education. This cost includes increasing the number of hours of service per week and having the service for the full school year.

Approval of the contract will be presented to the Board at the May 20, 2024 Board meeting.

#### D. <u>Mental Health Awareness</u>

May is Mental Health Awareness Month. The board will adopt a resolution at the May 6, 2024 workshop.
